

## **Film of the Sixties**

We will begin the class with an introduction to film analysis and documentary film techniques by viewing and discussing Newsreel's depiction of the Black Panthers. We will continue our look at documentary film with an investigation of direct cinema in the film *Crisis* that documents the integration of the University of Athens. After spending time with documentaries, we will explore changing film techniques with a look at *Bonnie and Clyde*.

The course will continue looking at fictional and documentary films. Each class will include an introduction to a film, placing it within the social and political climate of the time, a viewing of the film, and a discussion of what we've seen given those parameters.
