

## GREAT DECISIONS 2018

In a roundtable discussion format, this course focuses on eight important issues of American foreign policy as selected by The Foreign Policy Association. Topics for Spring 2018 are: The Waning of *Pax Americana?*; Russia's Foreign Policy; China and America: the New Geopolitical Equation; Media and Foreign Policy; Turkey: Partner or Opponent?; Global Engagement and the Military; South Africa's Fragile Democracy; and Global Health: Progress and Problems. An outside expert will set up the topic each week followed by robust discussion by the group, moderated by co-facilitators. A final class will provide a summary of themes, implications, and conclusions. Information on each topic will come from the Great Decisions program booklet, supplemented by other materials.
